DECLARATORY STATEMENT

The foregoing proceeding came before the Florida Building Commission (Commission) by a Petition from Janice Littler Finseth, for Structa Wire Corp. (Petitioner) that was received May 31, 2017. Based on the statements in the petition, the material subsequently submitted and the subsequent request by the Petitioner, the Commission states the following:

Findings of Fact

- 1. The Petition is filed pursuant to, and must conform to the requirements of Rule 28-105.002, Florida Administrative Code.
- 2. Petitioner's representative in this matter is Janice Littler Finseth, 1395 North Grandview Hwy., Vancouver, BC Canada V5N 1N2.
- 3. Petitioner engineers, manufactures, and markets welded wire stucco lathing products throughout North America, including Florida. Petitioner states that the following products are non-structural reinforcing compounds for use in stucco wall systems, and asserts that they have been tested and approved by IAPMO ER 2017: Structalath III No. 17 SFCR, Structalath III SFCR 316, Structalath No. 17 SFCR twin Trac 2.5, Structa Mega Lath, and Structa V Truss WC Lath II.
- 4. Petitioner seeks clarification of whether Rule 61G20-3.001, Florida Administrative Code, applies to its products.

5. Specifically, the Petitioner requests an answer to the following question based upon projects described within the petition for declaratory statement:

> Does Structa Wire require a separate Florida Building Report# to meet Florida Building requirements as per Rule 61G20 -3?

Conclusions of Law

- 6. The Commission has the specific statutory authority pursuant to Section 553.775(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2017) to interpret the provisions of the Florida Building Code by issuing a declaratory statement.
- Rule 61G20-3.002(31), Florida Administrative Code, defines "structural component" as "any part or assembly of buildings that comprises the main wind force resisting system and components or cladding."
- 8. Rule 61G20-3.002(33)(g), Florida Administrative Code, further specifies that subcategories of structural components include "truss plates, wood connectors, anchors, exterior coolers-freezers, insulation form systems, engineered lumber, pre-engineered air conditioner stands, structural wall components, and roof deck, and products introduced as a result of new technology."
 - 9. Section 2507, Florida Building Code, Building, 5th Edition (2014), states:

LATHING AND PLASTERING

2507.1 General.

Lathing and plastering materials and accessories shall be marked by the manufacturer's designation to indicate compliance with the appropriate standards referenced in this section and stored in such a manner to protect them from the weather.

2507.2 Standards.

Lathing and plastering materials shall conform to the standards listed in Table 2507.2 and Chapter 35 and, where required for fire protection, shall also conform to the provisions of Chapter 7.

- 10. Section 553.8425(6), Florida Statutes (2017), states that "[u]pon review of the compliance documentation, and a finding that the product complies with the code, the authority having jurisdiction or a local building official shall deem the product approved for use in accordance with its approval and limitation of use."
- 11. In response to Petitioner's question, the answer is no, pursuant to Rule 61G-3.001 Scope and Rule 61G-3.002 Definitions, Structa Wire product is not a structural component and

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therefore does not fall within the scope of Rule 61G20-3 State Product Approval. However, the product in question is subject to approval by the local authority having jurisdiction.

To initiate an appeal, a Notice of Appeal must be filed with the Agency Clerk, Department of Business and Professional Regulation, 2601 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2203 and with the appropriate District Court of Appeal not later than thirty (30) days after this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. A Notice of Appeal filed with the District Court of Appeal shall be accompanied by the filing fee specified by Section 35.22(3), Florida Statutes (2017).
